REVENUES

Maintenance Assessments

It is presently anticipated that the District will levy a Maintenance Assessment to all landowners within the District to funding the Operations and Maintenance for the fiscal year.

Interest Income

The District will have all excess funds invested with US Bank. The amount is based upon the estimated average balance of funds available during the fiscal year.

EXPENDITURES-ADMINISTRATIVE

Supervisor Fees

The Florida Statutes allows each board member to receive \$200 per meeting not to exceed \$4,800 in one year. The amount for the fiscal year is based upon all five supervisors attending the estimated 12 annual meetings.

FICA Payroll Taxes

Represents the Employer's share of Social Security and Medicare taxes withheld from Board of Supervisors checks.

Engineering Fees

The District's engineer will be providing general engineering services to the District, i.e. attendance and preparation for monthly board meetings, review invoices, etc.

Attorney

The District's legal counsel will be providing general legal services to the District, i.e. attendance and preparation for monthly meetings, review operating & maintenance contracts, etc.

Dissemination

The District is required by the Security and Exchange Commission to comply with Rule 15(c) (2)-12(b) (5), which relates to additional reporting requirements for un-rated bond issues.

Assessment Roll

Ongoing maintenance, review, and updating of assessment roll records to ensure accurate property ownership, valuation, classification, and taxation data. Governmental Management Services serves as the District's collection agent and certifies the District's non-ad valorem assessments with the county tax collector.

ADMINISTRATIVE: (CONTINUED)

Arbitrage

The District is required to have an annual arbitrage rebate calculation on the District's Bonds. The District will contract with an independent auditing firm to perform the calculations.

Annual Audit

The District is required annually to conduct an audit of its financial records by an Independent Certified Public Accounting Firm.

Trustee Fees

The District has issued Series 2023 bonds which are held with a Trustee at US Bank. The amount of the trustee fees is based on the agreement between US Bank and the District.

Management Fees

The District receives Management, Accounting and Administrative services as part of a Management Agreement with Governmental Management Services, LLC.

Information Technology

The District processes all of its financial activities, i.e., accounts payable, financial statements, etc. on a mainframe computer leased by Governmental Management Services.

Postage, Office Supplies, Phone, Copies

Mailing of agenda packages, overnight deliveries, correspondence, etc. Telephone and fax machine services. Printing and Binding services as well as printing of computerized checks, stationary, envelopes etc.

Rentals & Leases

Rental of meeting space at Hampton Inn & Suites Jacksonville Airport to accommodate District meetings. The estimated cost is \$360.00 per meeting, which may include room usage, standard seating arrangements, internet access, and basic meeting amenities.

Public Officials Insurance

The District's General Liability & Public Officials Liability Insurance policy is with Florida Insurance Alliance. Florida Insurance Alliance specializes in providing insurance coverage to governmental agencies. The amount is based upon similar Community Development Districts.

Legal Advertising

The District is required to advertise various notices for monthly Board meetings, public hearings etc. in a newspaper of general circulation.

Bank Fees

Bank charges and any other miscellaneous expenses that incurred during the year

Website Administration

Per Chapter 2014-22, Laws of Florida, all Districts must have a website by October 1, 2015 to provide detailed information on the CDD as well as links to useful websites regarding Compliance issues. This website will be maintained by GMS and updated monthly.

Dues, Licenses & Subscriptions

The District is required to pay an annual fee to the Florida Department of Commerce for \$175. This is the only expense under this category for the District.

FIELD EXPENDITURES:

Water

JEA supplies Water/Sewer services to the District.

Electric

The District has electric service throughout the Community serviced by JEA. These services include Streetlighting, clubhouse electric, etc.

Cable TV/Internet/Telephone

Cost of cable, internet services, and telephone/fax used for the Amenity Center.

Stormwater System Maintenance

The District currently contracts with The Lake Doctors for Aquatic Maintenance. The contract is \$605 per month.

Wetlands Monitoring/Maintenance

Repairs and maintenance to the District's Wetlands area.

Annual Stormwater Report

Prepare annual report to County.

General Liability & Property Casualty Insurance

The District's General Liability, Property and Flood Insurance policy is with Florida Insurance Alliance. Florida Insurance Alliance specializes in providing insurance coverage to governmental agencies.

Landscaping Maintenance:

The district has contracted with United Land Services to provide landscaping and fertilization maintenance throughout the common areas of the District.

Landscape Mulching

Landscaping extras that are not incorporated in regular landscaping costs. These include mulching the common areas.

Landscaping Plant Replacement Program

Represents any money set aside for landscaping extras that are not incorporated in regular landscaping costs.

FIELD EXPENDITURES (CONTINUED):

Irrigation Repairs & Maintenance

Represents funds that will be used to make repairs to the irrigation system, provide replacements and maintain equipment in the District.

R&M Drainage

Unscheduled maintenance and repairs.

PARKS AND RECREATION EXPENDITURES:

Field Services

Management of the field operations and clubhouse.

Amenity Management

Administration, operation, and oversight of community amenities and recreational facilities. Expenses may include staffing, scheduling, vendor coordination, access control, maintenance oversight, inspections, supplies, resident support services, and other operational costs associated with managing and maintaining community amenities for resident use and enjoyment.

Pool Monitors

Personnel assigned to monitor and oversee pool facilities to help ensure patron safety, enforce pool rules, maintain orderly operations, and support a clean and secure recreational environment. Expenses may include staffing costs, scheduling, uniforms, training, and related operational support for pool monitoring services.

Janitorial – Contract

Cleaning of the clubhouse and bathrooms.

Janitorial – Supplies/Other

Cleaning supplies necessary to maintain clean, sanitary, and safe facilities. Expenses may include cleaning chemicals, paper products, trash liners, disinfectants, restroom supplies, mops, brooms, gloves, and other miscellaneous custodial materials and related items not classified elsewhere.

Rental – Fitness Equipment

Fitness equipment lease for use at the clubhouse.

Contract – Fitness Classes

Instructors teaching fitness classes at the Clubhouse.

Access Control R&M

Any repairs and maintenance to the access control system for resident entry.

Pool Maintenance-Contract

Regular cleaning and maintenance of the pool.

Dog Waste Station Service and Supplies

Cleaning, emptying trash bins, and refreshing supplies for the Dog waste stations throughout the community.

Entrance Monument Wall R&M

Repairs and maintenance to the entrance monument walls.

Access Control – Contract

Security contract for the access control system.

Amenity Contingency

Unscheduled maintenance and repairs.

Special Events

The District will sponsor events throughout the year for residents.

Holiday Décor

Holiday decorations and lighting for the clubhouse.
